

Levy Information

Here is some additional information on the ambulance levy.

Here is an explanation of how the levy is set for the district. First, the district receives assessed valuations from both Camden and Miller County for the district. Once these numbers are received, they are entered on a form that is sent to the county clerk. The county clerk then sends it to the state auditor who will put the numbers in a formula to determine what our levy will be set at. By September 1, we are required to have a Public Hearing to go over the numbers we received from the state and put them in a formula using our assessed valuations to set the budget for the upcoming year. The public hearing is normally held in August and notice of this meeting is put in the legal ads in the Lake Sun Leader.

The voters of the district approved a \$0.30 levy in 2000 to allow the district to provide an ALS ambulance service. The first year the levy was assessed, the district received the full \$0.30. The following year, the Hancock Amendment came into play and reduced our levy amount. Currently the districts ambulance levy is set at \$0.2811.
